6 – Do I sing out a " <b>new song</b> " of praise to God?  (Are you experiencing spiritual freshness, excitement, full of wonder and awe)
7 – Does my Faith-Walk " <b>inspire others</b> " to trust the Lord?  (Consider what inspiration looks like in your life – how do you walk through trials, handle relationships, and care for others?)
